Jonathan Chaim Reus is an experimental composer, educator and art-science researcher who explores expanded forms of music-making and sonic art. His practice is rooted in long-term research trajectories that produce multiple artistic outputs. His work finds urgency in the meeting of differences in processing technological change, often leading him to create artwork at the boundaries of disciplinary or cultural identities and facilitating collaborations that lead to hybrid technological forms.
